Band Classifications

Classification will be determined by the total number of wind players. Bands will be grouped by similar sizes based on groups registered for the contest.

Awards

The top three bands in each class will receive 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place trophies. Additional 1st and 2nd place trophies will be awarded for music, guard, drum line, and drum major.

The Robert L. Maddox III trophy will be awarded to the band with the highest overall score in Classes A to AA. The Ed Benson trophy will be awarded to the band with the highest overall score in classes AAA and AAAA.

The Providence Cup will be awarded to the band with the highest overall score for the day.

The Award ceremony will be at 3:00 p.m.

Judging

Judges will be by captions. Ties will be broken by the music score. The outstanding judging panel will be listed in the final mailing. We are not using the state judging sheets.
